



## How to White List any Domain Name

Follow these instructions to “white list” [ezvoteonline.com](http://ezvoteonline.com), [lcvillage.org](http://lcvillage.org) or any other domain name to help keep messages from them from being tagged as spam. Adding the specific email address such as [support@ezvoteonline.com](mailto:support@ezvoteonline.com) as a contact in your “contact list” will also help.

### Yahoo Mail

1. In the top-right corner click on the "gear" icon (  ) next to **Settings**
2. Go to **More Settings – Filters**
3. Click on **+Add new filters** to create a filter
4. Under **Filter Name** give the filter a name such as "ezvote" or “LCVHOA”
5. Under **Set Rules**, under **From**, click on **Select a filter criterion** and choose "contains"
6. Where it says **Type a filter value enter** the domain name “**ezvoteonline.com**”
7. Leave the other entries blank and click **Save** to apply the changes. Your filter will show in the list under **Your Filters**. Repeat for the domain name “**lcvillage.org**.”

### Gmail

1. Open your inbox, click on the gear icon (  ) close to your Google account icon and select **Settings** then **See All Settings**
2. Select **Filters and Blocked Addresses** from the menu across the top and click on **Create a new filter** which is just below the list of any existing filters
3. In the **From** box write the domain name “**ezvoteonline.com**”
4. Click on **Create filter** in the bottom-right corner.
5. Tick the option **Never send it to Spam**.
6. Press **Create Filter**, in the bottom-left corner and you’re done. Messages from ezvote should now go to your inbox. Repeat for the domain name “**lcvillage.org**.”

### Outlook

1. **Under Settings**, click on **View all Outlook Settings**
2. Select **Junk Email** and under **Safe Senders and domains** click on **Add**
3. Enter “**ezvoteonline.com**”
4. Press **Save** and you’re done. Repeat for the domain name “**lcvillage.org**.”

### AOL Mail

1. Log into you AOL webmail account
2. Go to the **Contacts** section, located on the left side and add a **New Contact**
3. In the **Email1** box type [support@ezvoteonline.com](mailto:support@ezvoteonline.com)
3. Click **Add Contact** and you’re done! Repeat for [communications@lcvillage.org](mailto:communications@lcvillage.org) and [propertymanager@lcvillage.org](mailto:propertymanager@lcvillage.org).
